Meeting called to order: 7:08pm

### Old Business:

- Construction update: Pavilion Roof looks like a September construction. Date still not confirmed.

### New Business:

- Flood update: Bob Gill has high resolution photos of the flooding (swamp) behind the RC area. He traced down the cause to both the Maritz water runoff pipe as well as a huge area of gravel impounding the water. He manually dug a 2 foot by 20-foot trench and has pictures of the increased water flow which lowered the water level measurably. Because of this, GSLMA and Bob Gill will be meeting with the County personnel this Thursday to discuss how to dredge out the obstruction and dry out not only the swamp behind the RC area but also to eliminate the large ponds on both the west and east sides of the RC field.
- First Aid: We had a pilot cut his finger on a prop so seriously that he had to go to Urgent Care to have his finger professionally attended. Fortunately, there was a paramedic and a doctor on-site when this happened, and they said the first aid supplies were inadequate. As a result, a motion was made and passed to have GSLMA obtain proper first aid kits for the RC, Control Line and Drone areas.
